Universal Community Testing Programme

Thank you for your continuous co-operation and support for our School's contingency arrangements in learning and teaching in the past months. As the COVID-19 has shown signs of subsiding recently, the Education Bureau has announced that all schools will resume face-to-face class teaching in two phases. The first phase will start on 23 September 2020 (Wednesday) and the second phase will start on 29 September 2020 (Tuesday). Classes will be conducted on a half-day basis in order to reduce the risk of infection. Please refer to Circular 2 for details.

The Universal Community Testing Programme (UCTP) was launched by the Government since 1 September 2020 to identify asymptomatic patients in the community and cut the invisible transmission chain. The Government has decided to extend the UCTP for four days to 11 September 2020 (Friday) after reviewing the experience from the operation of the community testing centres as well as public's demand for the testing service. We take this opportunity to encourage you to capitalize on the opportunity in the next few days and arrange for your children and family members to participate in the UCTP if not yet done so. This is to protect the health of all school staff and students, and to create a more favourable condition for the upcoming resumption of face-to-face class teaching. The epidemic situation may still fluctuate in the future. We have made preparations for this "new normal", and will remain agile and flexibly deploy different modes of teaching as appropriate. We also appeal to parents and students for your understanding and support.
