## School Hours and Timetable for Half-day School 2021-22

According to EDB latest announcement, all primary schools can arrange for students to attend face-to-face classes in the morning ONLY for no more than half a day and no mass events should be arranged. In response to this policy, we have adjusted our school timetable so that students will be able to enjoy face-to-face lesson hours similar as in whole day school, i.e. lessons hours, number of recess, and CCA activities will remain unchanged.

To achieve this goal, two minor adjustments will be made:

1. School will start at **8:15 a.m.** instead of 8:25 a.m., dismissal time remain unchanged at 1:15 p.m.
2. The 10<sup>th</sup> lesson, which is homework lesson (from Monday to Thursday) and MCE (Moral Civic Education) (Friday) will be held online through TEAMS at 3:00 p.m. daily.
