Arrangements for Whole-school Resumption

In response to the announcement made by the Education Bureau announced on May 11, our school will resume on campus face-to-face classes arrangements with effect from May 24 (Monday). Arrangements are as below:

A) Lessons Arrangements for P.1- P.6 Updated arrangements

1. **ALL LEVELS** will have face-to-face lessons using the regular 10 lessons per day timetable starting from May 24. A copy of the timetable will be distributed to all students.
2. All lessons will start at 8:25 a.m. and finish at 1:15 p.m.

B) P.6 Graduation Examination and P.1 –P.5 Final Examination Updated arrangements

1. P.6 Graduation Examination and P.1 –P.5 Final Examination will be held as scheduled as in Notice 36. **Please note that P1-2 examination dates are not the same as P3-6.** The dates and school hours for examination dates are updated and summarized below.
