28 th July 2022 (Thursday) & 29 th July 2022 (Friday)	Registration of S1 Students
2 nd August 2022 (Tuesday)	Pre-S1 Hong Kong Attainment Test

P.6 students should come in person to collect the results according to normal school hours. Parents will be arranged to wait at the school hall while results are being given out to students. S1 entrants are required to take part in the Pre-S1 Test in their registered secondary schools in the morning of **Tuesday, 2 August 2022**.

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Reminder On Secondary School Places Allocation 2020/2022

1. Pupils/Parents must report to the secondary school allocated for registration according to the specified date, time and place printed on the **ADMISSION SLIP** during the registration period (i.e. 28th July 2022 or 29th July 2022); otherwise, places allocated will **NOT** be reserved for your child. However, in case of extreme difficulties, parents concerned should contact the School Places Allocation (SPA) Section (Tel. No. 2832 7740) before the end of the registration period so that alternative arrangements for registration may be made.
2. The Admission Slip portion must be surrendered to the secondary school allocated upon registration and the Allocation Slip portion is to be retained by the parent.
3. In case of transfer, parent has to retrieve the Admission Slip from the secondary school with which he has registered and hand it to the school of transfer. **Remember that by retrieving the Admission Slip, registration with the secondary school allocated will at the same time be canceled.**
4. Secondary schools will not admit any students without an Admission Slip. This practice will continue until 31 August 2022 so as to ensure that no student will be holding more than one S1 place.
5. For registration, parents should bring along the following documents of the students: Admission Slip; Hong Kong Birth Certificate, Hong Kong Identity Card, or other documentary evidence showing the permanent resident status in Hong Kong; the latest school reports and two recent passport-sized photographs.
6. Parents should also bring along their children's valid traveling documents if the symbol 'C' (for conditional stay) is found at the line below the date of birth of student's Hong Kong Identity Card.
7. If the pupil and the parents will be away from **Hong Kong during the registration period**, representatives must bring along with them a **Letter of Authorization** for the collection of allocation results and registration with the secondary schools allocated on behalf of the student during the registration period; otherwise, places will not be reserved.

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8. In case of Allocation Slip/Admission Slip is lost, a handling fee of \$125.00 will be charged for a replacement. Application for replacement can be made to the SPA section.
9. Students' personal data which are allocation-related will be disclosed to their primary schools, the secondary schools they are allocated to or transferred and other government departments, if and when so required, for verification of information and other education-related purposes.
10. Should the territory be affected by tropical cyclones, persistent heavy rain, or thunderstorms on the day of announcement of allocation results or on any day(s) designed for registration, announcements for special arrangements will be made on the radio/television.

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
