Please note that your child will participate in the Hong Kong Schools Speech Festival (Chinese Solo Verse Speaking). You are requested to shoot a video for your child with your digital camera or mobile phone at home or other appropriate venues.

Points to be noted about the shooting the video:

1. You are encouraged to shoot the video of your child in a safe and quiet area so that he/she can take off the mask during the video recording.
2. You may use landscape or portrait mode to shoot the video.
3. Your child should wear **proper** uniform.
4. Make sure the video can clearly show his/her whole body, appearance, actions and facial expression.
5. Your child must announce his/her **full name** and **the name of the poem** before reciting the poem. (Example: My name is Marianne Harper. "Dressing Up" by Jane Clarke.)
6. The video must be a single shot video footage. No editing is allowed.
