Attachment

As new and emerging technologies continue to change the world we live in, they provide an opportunity for many unique and positive educational benefits to the classroom. Therefore, Sir Ellis Kadoorie (S) Primary School has decided to implement a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Policy. It is important that students and parents are familiar with the terms under which these devices can be used within Sir Ellis Kadoorie (S) Primary School.

Definitions used:

- 1. Devices refer to Sir Ellis Kadoorie (S) Primary School approved iPads, notebook computers or any similar products.
- 2. The acronym BYOD stands for "Bring Your Own Device". Students will be allowed to bring in their own devices to be used in classrooms under the direct supervision of their teachers.

Filtering and Monitoring:

- 1. Sir Ellis Kadoorie (S) Primary School filters contents for student access to the Internet. However at times, inappropriate material may get past the filters and be viewed by the student. Students should report the occurrence to their teachers or the IT department. Students will be held accountable for any deliberate attempt to bypass the district filters and security.
- 2. Access through the wireless network may be monitored and/or recorded for the purposes of network security and student safety.
- 3. All devices must be registered with Sir Ellis Kadoorie (S) Primary School IT department. <u>Sir Ellis Kadoorie</u> (S) Primary School reserves the right to monitor, inspect, access and review all devices, which includes but not limited to personal emails and Internet access.

Security:

A label from IT department with student ID will be stuck to the back of the registered device. These labels are **NOT** to be removed or modified. If they become damaged or missing, students can contact technical support for replacement. All devices must be stored in locked lockers when not in use.

Charging:

Students are responsible for the maintenance and charging of the battery of their devices. To ensure productivity, students are expected to come to school every day with a fully charged battery.

Guidelines

Below are guidelines for students using their personal devices around school campus.

- 1. Students can only use School approved devices under teachers' supervision or with their approval.
- 2. Students can use their devices for educational purposes only.
- 3. Students can only use School approved applications or programs on their devices.
- 4. Students can only email or communicate with others through their devices on school campus with teachers' permission. Students are prohibited to make contact with any person via social media during school hours this includes contacting parents, other students or people outside School.
- 5. Students can only access the Internet via Sir Ellis Kadoorie (S) Primary School's wireless network and not their private mobile networks (e.g. 3G/4G/5G). Students are allowed to use devices which support Wi-Fi only.
- 6. Sir Ellis Kadoorie (S) Primary School is not liable for any loss, damage, or thievery of devices brought to school.
- 7. Sir Ellis Kadoorie (S) Primary School reserves the rights to censor websites which are not educational.
- 8. Students can only listen to audio files with teachers' permission on school campus with in-ear headphones.

 The volume should be kept at a level that doesn't disrupt others.
- 9. Students must comply with copyright laws.
- 10. Any gaming devices or consoles are considered as forbidden articles.
- 11. Students are prohibited from photo-taking or video/voice recordings without their teachers' permission. The violation of such policy will result in suspension the use of the devices.
- 12. Students cannot use their device for inappropriate communications. These include but are not limited to the following: harassing, bullying, threatening, personal attack, obscene, vulgar language or images that may cause damage to an individual or the school.
- 13. Students are prohibited from modifying their devices illegally.
- 14. Students are prohibited from removing any MDM certificates installed in their devices.
- 15. Students should never share username and passwords with other students or staff.

Consequences for Violations:

- 1. Bringing your own device is a privilege and not a right. Students who do not observe the guidelines will face disciplinary action and lose the privilege to utilize their devices for a period of time.
- 2. If reasonable belief exists that the student has violated the terms of this agreement, or other school policy, the student's device may be inspected and/or confiscated.
- 3. Any student violating the terms of this agreement would receive punishment(s) including warnings, demerit(s), and/ or forfeiture of the rights to bring their devices to school.
- 4. Sir Ellis Kadoorie (S) Primary School reserves the right to impose higher level sanctions at any time depending on the nature of the violation.
