Participating students will be put into one of the following categories based on their grades:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Category 1 – Primary 1 and Primary 2 students</li><li>b. Category 2 – Primary 3 and Primary 4 students</li><li>c. Category 3 – Primary 5 and Primary 5 students</li></ol></li><li>2. The two students with the highest scores from each category of each school will proceed to the Qualifier Round.</li><li>3. A new set of stories for each category will be emailed to the teacher-in-charge of each school TWO WEEKS before the competition. The teacher will distribute the stories to the participating students.</li><li>4. Each participant is required to narrate each part in English, Cantonese and Putonghua as assigned.</li><li>5. A workshop (in ZOOM meetings) will be arranged by the Teacup Productions. This workshop is a <u>prerequisite</u> of the above competition. Detail will be notified to the student in due course.</li></ol> |
